SLICK is a revolutionary, innovative and interactive series of student leadership workshops geared towards nurturing the leadership skills within students to achieve personal growth, resulting in a desire to create positive change in their lives and community.

According to John M. Bridgeland's Silent Epidemic: "the decision to drop out is a dangerous one for the student. Dropouts are much more likely than their peers who graduate to be unemployed, living in poverty, receiving public assistance, in prison, on death row, unhealthy, divorced, and single parents with children who drop out from high school themselves. Additionally, " nearly half (47%) said a major reason for dropping out was that classes were not interesting" SLiCK is a highly interactive program that does not allow for our participants to become uninterested. Throughout the SLiCK process we teach our students how to become more engaged in their education." SLiCK is working hard to ensure we do our part to prevent our students from not finishing high school.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- **SLiCK** helps meet Title I, part C statutory requirements for sections 1304(c)(6); 1306(b)
- **SLICK** is an educationally related activity provided to students to help them succeed both inside and outside of the classroom.
- **SLICK** is a scientifically based research program that has shown improvement in LEP scores, attrition, grades, and interest in college.
- **SLICK** can be implemented as a Saturday or vacation program, after school program, or a summer program.
- SLICK helps address the following student issues;
 - Academic achievement
 - Cultural and language barriers
 - Social isolation
 - Leadership skills
 - Communication skills
 - Graduation rates
 - Successful transition to a postsecondary education
- SLICK is successful because:
 - We fully engage each, and every, participant.
 - We ask the questions that most schools are unable to get answers to such as:
 - Why are you struggling in school?
 - What kind of problems are you facing outside of the classroom?
 - Why are you behaving the way you are?
 - Do you thoroughly understand the consequences of failing out of high school?
 - Where do you see yourself 5 years from now?
 - What else are you doing that is bringing stress to your life?
 - Our participants feel safe, and comfortable enough to share their stories, struggles, and dreams with us.
 - Our program is fast paced, and full of interactive, hands-on, learning activities.
 - We always teach by example by using our own stories.
 - Our students know we believe in them therefore resulting in an increased belief in themselves.

Over the course of the program, the **SLiCK** Team engages students with a combination of motivational presentations, team building activities, small group discussions and individual personal development assignments.

The program is designed to:

- Prevent high school dropout rates from increasing through student engagement.
- Provide students with the purpose, tools and direction necessary to achieve personal and academic success far beyond high school.
- Produce active student leaders who will serve their families, schools and communities with distinction and encourage other students to do the same via education.
- Institute leadership, pride and education as important keys to success.






